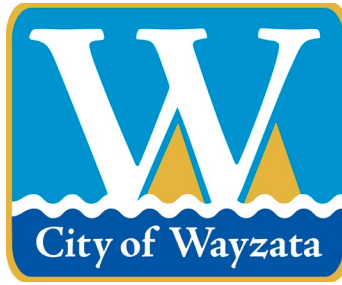

Work Shop: Discuss Extension of Dakota Rail Trail in Wayzata

Update

As staff has continued to work with Three Rivers Park District on the Lake Effect Project, the section of Lake Street between Ferndale Avenue and Barry Avenue has been an increasing topic of discussion.

This trail segment was identified as “the bridge to nowhere” by some residents this fall because there would be a gap between the new Lake Street trail improvements and the Dakota Rail Trail on the west side of Ferndale. See the attached exhibits that show the existing trail route versus the preferred trail route.

Recently, officials at Three Rivers Park District have indicated that due to the importance of this stretch of trail, including a new, safer, and less confusing crossing at Ferndale, they have allocated the cost of the segment, both design and construction, in their Capital Improvements Plan. Meaning, if the City is agreeable, Three Rivers would fund the design and construction of the trail segment parallel with the Lake Street Improvements.

The objective of this work shop item will be to discuss the trail segment, design process, and funding from Three Rivers. If the Council desires to move forward, a design contract could be considered at the first meeting in January.

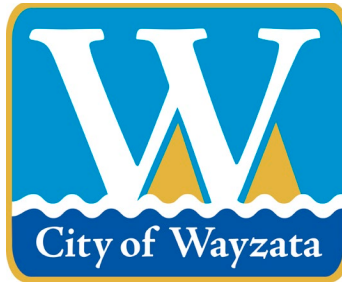
- Dakota Rail Trail proposed extension on Lake street
