Re: Log Cabin Relocation – Workshop Discussion

Per the City Council's workshop discussion with the Heritage Preservation Board, on March 18th, staff walked the Shaver Park site to review potential locations for the log cabin. After reviewing various location options against sightlines, low water areas, and access to the general public, staff is recommending that the Log Cabin be located on the south side of the Three Rivers Park Kiosks. Locating the cabin in this location provides the public with walking path access to the cabin to create another park amenity that is more centrally located than if the cabin was located in the upper western section of the park. In addition, locating the cabin adjacent to the existing kiosks helps screen the cabin from view of adjacent properties, and allows for partnership with the Three Rivers Park District to do some interpretative signage on the back side of the kiosks about the history and story of the cabin.

Staff is looking for City Council direction on if this is an acceptable site for the relocation of the cabin. If agreed upon by the City Council, staff would create a stable foundation to locate the cabin on top of, and provide a connection to the existing walkway.

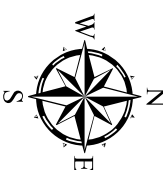
Attached is a map of the recommended site location. Staff will have photos of the potential site available for Tuesday's meeting.

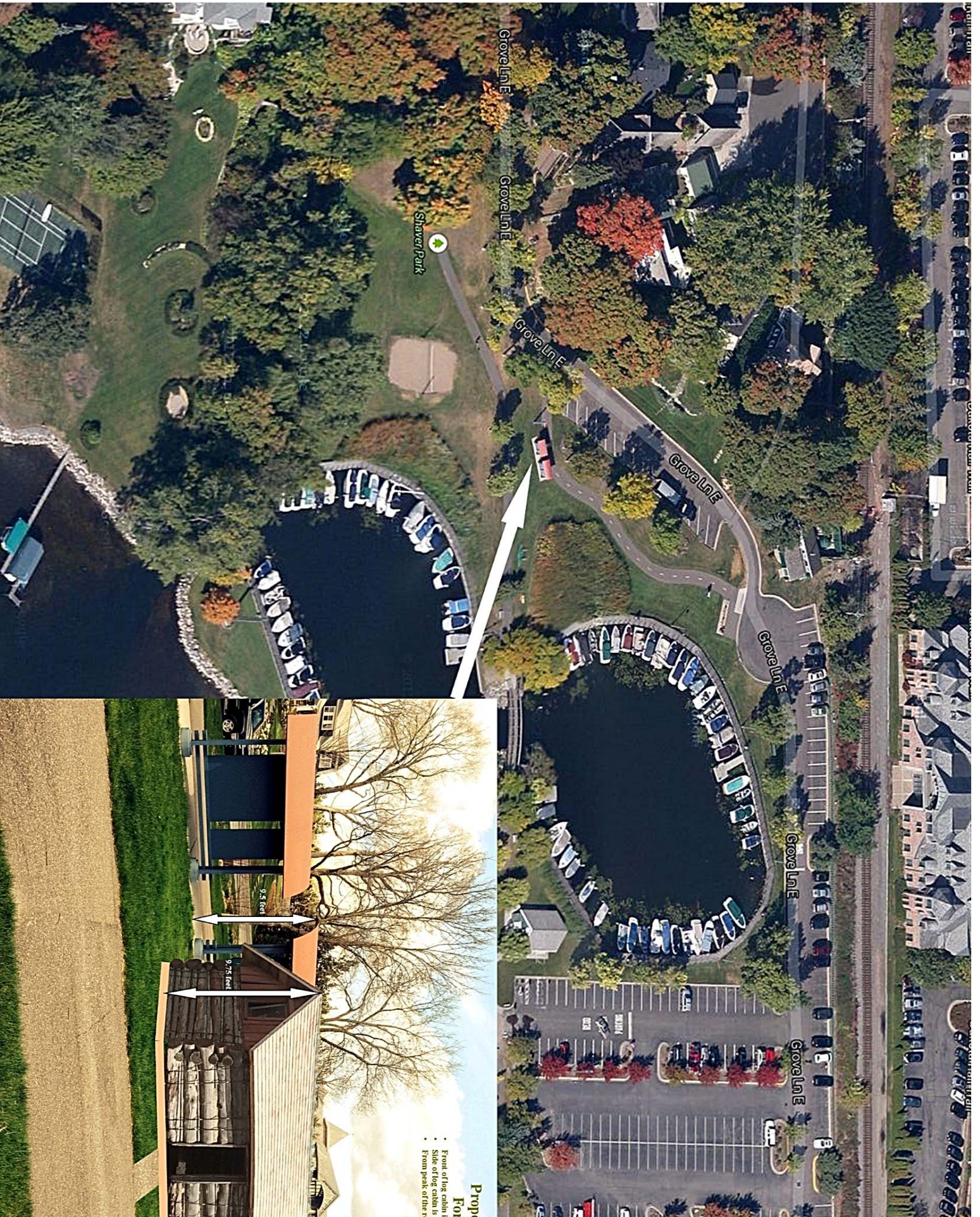


Log Cabin Potential Locations: Shaver Park & City Marina

Proposed Location For Log Cabin

- Front of log cabin is about 16.5 feet wide
- Side of log cabin is about 12 feet wide
- From peak of the roof to grounds about 9.75 feet
