

**WAYZATA CITY COUNCIL
WORKSHOP MEETING MINUTES
May 20, 2014**

6:15 PM DISCUSS POTENTIAL SITES FOR LOG CABIN

The Wayzata City Council assembled at 6:15 p.m. in the Community Room at Wayzata City Hall for a workshop meeting to discuss potential sites for the log cabin. Mayor Willcox was present. Council members present: Amdal, Anderson, Mullin and Tanner. Also present: City Manager Nelson, and City Planner Gadow.

Per the City Council's workshop discussion with the Heritage Preservation Board, on March 18, staff walked the Shaver Park site to review potential location for the log cabin. Staff recommended that the log cabin be located on the south side of the Three Rivers Park kiosks. Staff asked for City Council direction on the placement of the log cabin. The Council discussed potential locations within Shaver Park, including concerns with water level in the staff identified location. Staff also reviewed a potential location in Klapprich Park, adjacent to the existing walkway on the eastern end of the park. The Council supported locating the log cabin in the southwest corner of Shaver Park to locate it among the forested area, and on higher ground. Staff indicated that they would begin the process of preparing the site for the foundation on which the log cabin would be placed, in the location supported by the Heritage Preservation Board and the City Council.

The workshop meeting was adjourned at 6:45 p.m.
