DISCUSSION OBJECTIVE:

To Update the Council on the Interim City Manager Transition Plan and Recruitment Firm Process.

2024-2026 STRATEGIC PLAN PRIORITIES RELEVANCE:

BACKGROUND:

In July, the Council appointed Public Works Director/City Engineer Mike Kelly as Interim City Manager following the resignation of City Manager Jeff Dahl and during Deputy City Manager Aurora Yager's maternity leave. With Ms. Yager's return on October 1, Mr. Kelly will work with her to transition responsibilities through October 15, as directed by the Council. Mayor Mullin and Councilmember Sorensen will update the Council on this transition.

Since being appointed, Mr. Kelly solicited proposals from five firms to assist with the recruitment of a new City Manager. All five firms submitted proposals. Those firms were:

- David Drown Associates
- Mosaic Public Partners, LLC
- MGT Impact Solutions, LLC, formerly GovHR USA (GovHR)
- Strategic Government Resources
- CliftonLarsonAllen LLP

A subcommittee of Mayor Mullin and Councilmember Sorensen reviewed the proposals and narrowed the candidate field to three firms.

On Friday, September 26, the City Council interviewed the three firms. Council members that attended the interviews will discuss the three firms with the goal of coming to consensus on a preferred firm.
